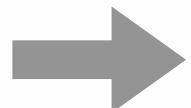

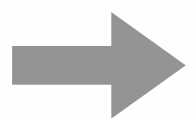

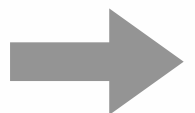

## The Sydney Guide

Are you interested in traveling to one of the countries in Oceania? If so, we would like you to visit Australia. Do you know that Australia is the largest island and also the smallest continent in the world? It is surrounded by the Indian and the Pacific Oceans and it also has a large desert area, so you will have unique nature experiences for sure.

Although Australia has many attractive cities like Canberra, Adelaide, Melbourne, we strongly recommend visiting Sydney. Sydney is located on the southeast coast facing the Tasman Sea, and is the largest and oldest city in Australia. Many tourists from around the world come to the city every year to enjoy various tourist attractions.

We'll show you a few fantastic examples.

Sydney is a beautiful city built around its Harbor. The Sydney Opera House is the most famous building there. It is well-known for the unique shape of its roof covered with more than a million Swedish white tiles. In the Opera House about 40 performances are given every week, so you can enjoy Australia's latest shows. If you like, you can join the backstage tour for about two hours. This tour starts at seven a.m. each day and a ticket costs 175 dollars, including a delicious breakfast.

When you have some time to relax, you should go to Bondi Beach. It takes just thirty minutes by car to reach it from the center of Sydney. The beach is famous not only for its beautiful white sands but also for being the birth place of lifesaving. You can enjoy swimming or surfing in a safe environment, with lifesavers watching you on the beach. Before you go back to the city, why don't you take a walk along the beach? There are many nice restaurants, cafes, and souvenir shops.

If you want to know about Aboriginal Australians, it is a good idea to visit the Blue Mountains National Park. It is located about two hours west of Sydney and has more than a million hectares of forest, containing many eucalyptus trees, valleys, caves, and waterfalls. This park was registered as a World Heritage Site in 2000 and you can explore this great area by trail walking, cycling, or driving. In this park, there are many sites that show tourists how the Aborigines lived many years ago. For example, visitors can see a small cave in which Aborigines lived more than ten thousand years ago and some hand prints on a cave wall left behind about a thousand years ago. You can also see a great rock formation called the Three Sisters. According to an Aboriginal legend, there were three beautiful sisters who fell in love with three men from another tribe. The powerful tribe leader turned the sisters into rocks to protect them, but he was killed in the fighting, and no one else could turn them back. The three rock pillars stand side by side to this day.
