Singapore is a country in Southeast Asia. It is a city-state. This means that it is an independent country that has only one city. Singapore is an island near the bottom of the Malay Peninsula. A peninsula is a piece of land that has water on three sides. Singapore is one of the top ten richest countries in the world and thanks to its economy, it is a very wealthy nation.

Singapore has become a very important business hub because of its location. It is a good stopping point for ships that are traveling between Asia and Europe or Africa. When international trading was mostly done by ships, Singapore became a very important port. Today, Singapore is the fifth largest port in the world and has become a center for world business. This means that Singapore has a strong economy which makes it different from many other Southeast Asian countries.

Tourism is another important area of Singapore's economy. Many tourists travel to Singapore because it is a clean and safe country that has delicious food and many exciting attractions. Let's take a look at three of them.

1. Marina Bay Waterfront Promenade

This is a 3.5-kilometer long walkway. The promenade is designed as an environment-friendly recreation area. There are lots of mist sprays and breeze shelters with fans to protect visitors from the blazing Singapore heat. Marina Bay is a real beauty of nature, surrounded by fancy skyscrapers, uniquely architectural buildings and no day out here is complete without visiting Wonder Full and The Helix Bridge. Wonder Full - a free nightly spectacular of the largest laser lights and water show accompanied by orchestral music in Southeast Asia. The Helix Bridge - a pedestrian bridge which has a double helix that resembles the structure of DNA. Four viewing platforms are located along the bridge for visitors to enjoy breathtaking views of the Singapore skyline.

2. Orchard Road

Orchard Road is a 2.2-kilometer long shopping and entertainment avenue in the heart of Singapore. Its name originated a long time ago when the place was a farming area filled with fruit orchards. The fruit trees have all disappeared now and in their place are luxury shopping malls, restaurants and hotels. Once there, you will be amazed by the wide variety of goods for sale from various shops, especially during The Great Singapore Sale, a yearly event.

3. Explore Singapore on a Bumboat

A bumboat is a small boat or water taxi that is used for quick journeys and river tours. They are often painted with eyes and faces. A bumboat ride down the Singapore River is the cheapest and fastest way to see the stunning downtown views.

Other famous places to see.


The Merlion is the most famous landmark in Singapore. The 8.6-meter statue is half-lion and half-fish. It sits at one end of the Marina Bay waterfront.


